EVENT GUIDELINES

Tires: The tire of choice will be the Hoosier 790 7" tire on a 8" wheel.

Rulebook: All competitors understand that by submitting an entry form for an ASA Midwest Sportsman Tour event, they have agreed to abide by these rules and regulations as well as any changes that may be ordered by the ASA Midwest Tour officials at any event.

Fuel: Competition Race Fuels is the official fuel of the ASAMT. There is no minimum requirement to purchase fuel for Sportsman competitors but we ask that everyone use CRF during 2010.

Membership Policy: Membership Policy: All FULL TIME car owners and drivers must obtain an ASA Midwest Tour Membership license to be eligible to participate in an ASAMST Event. In order to receive or be eligible for year end point fund monies you must participate in at least 75 percent of all ASAMST events and finish in the top 20 in final point standings. Bonuses, Contingencies, etc- In order to qualify for event bonuses, contingencies, or banquet drawings you must be a season long ASAMST Member. Car owner and Driver Temporary members will be \$20 and limited to 3 events before being required to purchase a full membership. Local race track competitors are NOT required to purchase a temporary membership but it is highly recommended.

Raceceivers: All Sportsman competitors are required to have a one way raceceiver in order to allow the race director to communicate with all drivers. The frequency code will be provided at each race. No spotters are allowed in the Sportsman division.

CONTINGENCY AWARDS

The posted awards for the event include purse monies, point fund allocations and contingency prize monies. Awards listed are subject to change from date of publication to race day. Refer to the event fact sheet for updated information. To receive awards, teams must satisfy all manufacturer's requirements (decals, patches and race interview criteria)

CONTINGENCY DECAL POLICY

Decals are Mandatory! All participating cars in ASA Midwest Sportsman Tour sanctioned events are required to display ALL decals in their assigned locations as outlined by the 2010 ASA Midwest Sportsman Tour Decal Placement Sheet. Decals MUST be in place prior to any on-track appearance at an ASA Midwest Tour event. Failure to comply with the decal placement assignment subjects the entrant to fine, loss of points and/or prize monies, probation and/or suspension. The drivers last name MUST be displayed on both sides of the rocker panel in 5" clearly visible lettering.

Temporary Membership Fees are NOT mandatory for local competitors but are HIGHLY recommended. Drivers that do not purchase a temporary membership are not eligible for the full benefits of the ASA Insurance Policy. Temp fees are \$20 for the driver or any crew member if they are purchased. Drivers/Owners will be required to purchase a full membership after exceeding 25 percent of ASAMST events. All monies previously paid by Driver/Owners will be applied to the full membership)
