

LATE TIRE RULE: (Subject to Availability)

- A. All tires that are to be used in the competition must be purchased from Elko Speedway.
- **B.** All tires that are to be used in competition must be designated to a specific driver and registered by Elko Track Officials.
- **c**. There is absolutely no sharing, borrowing, or transferring of registered competition tires between drivers.

Important Note! - Failure to comply with the above A, B, or C. will cause the driver(s) to be disqualified from the related event as well as forfeiture of all points and purse money.

D. On a driver's, first night of competition, the driver will be permitted to register up to, six (6) competition tires. After the first night event and for the remainder of the season the driver can register the following competition tires for every night the driver competes.

 $June 28^{th} - 2$ $July 5^{th} - 1$ $July 19^{th} - 2$ $August 2^{nd} - 1$ $August 16^{th} - 2$ $August 30^{th} - 1$ $September 13^{th} - 2$ $September 20^{th} - 1$

E. Drivers are permitted to use any legally registered competition tires at any time throughout the season.

Important Note! - Drivers that do not compete in the first race of the season or show up to race throughout the season can register up to six competition tires on their first night of the competition. However, to adjust for an advantage those drivers might have, they will be required to start the first feature behind the inversion according to their qualifying result. Their starting spot for the second feature will not be impacted.

THE TIRE BUILDING WILL BE CLOSING EACH NIGHT AT 4:30PM. ALL TIRES MUST BE PURCHASED AND REMOVED FROM THE TIRE BUILDING BEFORE THAT TIME.
